



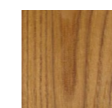

Dining tables available for indoor and outdoor use with structure featuring legs in shaped solid Teak wood Ø65 mm, and AISI 304 Stainless Steel crosspieces matt black painted, joined together by moulded plastic corner brackets; black-painted Doluflex under-top panel, screwed to the base, coupled with an anti-slip material, with centering elements for fixing to the supporting top.

Table tops available in 12 mm thick Porcelain Stoneware (straight cut) in the colors and finishes available in the collection, or in 20 mm thick Black Absolute Zimbabwe Granite. Floor support is provided by plastic tips.

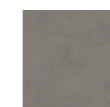

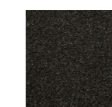

Notes

Wood is a living material; therefore, it can have slight color and dimension changes. The presence of any non-homogeneous color shades is not to be considered a defect but a quality.

PORCELAIN STONWARE: Porcelain stoneware is an extremely dense ceramic material obtained by mixing various natural raw materials, such as clay and sand, and fired at high temperatures to make it waterproof and non-porous. The resulting surfaces have an absorption rate of less than 0.5%. Porcelain stoneware is known for its durability, characterized by a surface hardness that makes it resistant to wear, scratches, and most physical and mechanical stresses. In addition, it is a safe material, resistant to high temperatures and thermal shocks, and NSF certified for direct food contact. Porcelain stoneware slabs do not contain volatile organic compounds (VOCs), which can be potentially toxic to humans and the environment, nor do they contain formaldehyde. They are also free from PVC, plastics, or petroleum derivatives.

GRANITE: of uniform colour, granite is a hard stone of volcanic origin and is an "intrusive rocks", which emerge from solidified magma inside the earth's crust; for its particular nature, granite is a very resistant material to abrasion and compression and easy to be maintained.

TEAK: Teak wood comes from certified plantations, and it is an extremely durable material, resistant to weathering and acids, because of the presence of an oil-resin component that ensures exceptional durability. It features a wide range of colors that vary greatly, from pale yellow to bronze, with a reddish hue. Extended and continuous exposure to weathering agents changes its surface layer, leading to oxidation that gives it a gray-silver tone. A regular maintenance helps to preserve the wood's original color over time; any differences in color should be considered as qualities rather than defects, as they are a characteristic feature of Teak.

For wooden finishing the "Outdoor Wood" Maintenance Kit is included with the product.

We recommend placing the product on terraces or verandas to guarantee its durability over the years. It is recommended to use a "Protective Cover" to improve the longevity of the product.
